### Sub: Advertisement for Engaging Teachers on Contract Basis, in AEC School Mysuru for the Academic year 2026-27

It is proposed to conduct a Skill test and Practical classroom observation (or a Demo Teaching class) for engaging teachers on contract basis against the leave / regular vacancies that may arise during the Academic Year 2026-27. The details of post, pay, eligibility criterion and minimum and maximum age limits are given below.

#### **1. Educational and other Qualifications for the Post of Graduate Teacher (PGT)**

##### **Essential Qualifications:**

i) Integrated Post Graduate Course from NCTE recognized university, in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate including B. Ed. Component.

OR

Master Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate in the following subjects:

ii) B.Ed. Degree from NCTE recognized institution/ University with at least 50% marks. OR

Three years integrated B.Ed. - M.Ed from NCTE recognized Institution / University with at least 50% marks. OR

Four years Integrated Degree with atleast 50% marks from NCTE recognized Institution / University including B.Ed. Component.

##### **DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Experience as TGT /PGT in the recognized institutions in concerned subject.
- Experience of working in a school.
- Knowledge of Computer application.

**\*\* Graduation in concerned subject with at least 50% marks and 1-year B.Ed. (Special Education) from Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) with atleast 50% marks. OR Post Graduate in concerned subject with a minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade and three-year**

  - a) **Working knowledge of Computer.**
  - b) **Proficiency in teaching in English medium.**
- iii) **Candidates without teaching qualification (B.Ed.,D.El.Ed, B.EL.Ed, CTET) can also apply and will be empanelled separately on selection.**

### **MODE OF SELECTION**

1. (a) A skill test and Practical classroom observation (or a Demo Teaching Class) will be conducted and the selected candidates will be empanelled and recruited in the order of merit.  
(b) Performance of the candidates will be assessed based on presentation by the candidates on two topics, one chosen by self and other provided by the school followed by personnel interaction on the subject
2. 3 panels will be prepared:
  - a. Panel I – Candidates with all the **requisite Teaching** qualifications for PGTs, TGTs, PRTs and Preparatory (Balvatika) teachers separately

- b. Panel II – Candidates **without CTET score** for TGTs and PRTs separately
- c. Panel III – Candidates **without teaching qualification** for PGTs, TGTs, PRTs and Balvatika teachers separately
- The panels mentioned above will be operated in sequential order viz. in the order of their merit.
  - The panel is valid for one year – 1st April 2026 to 31st March 2027.
  - If the performance of the Contract teacher, any time during the period of contract, is not found as per the required standards, the contract can be terminated.
  - Contract teachers have to follow Conduct Rules prescribed by AEES during the service. Violation of Conduct of Rules can lead to termination of contract.
