The Inter AEES Art Competition was held on 22nd October 2024.



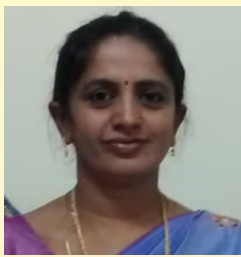

Hindi Pakhwada was celebrated from 1st to 14th of September 2024. Competitions for both students and teachers were conducted.

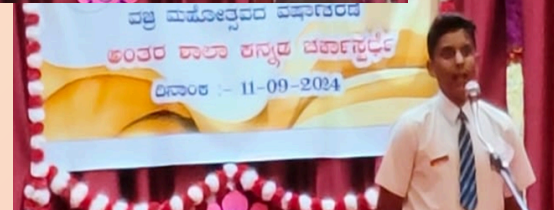
AECS Mysore organized the School-level Rastriya Bal Vigyanik Pradarshini on 27th August 2024 for students from Classes IV to XII.
