Such clouds bring rain to the continents; for instance, the monsoon rains we in India expect every summer originate in the ocean-without such rains, our agriculture and all life will suffer. But oceans often also give rise to stormsviolent events with extreme rainfall or very strong winds, such as cyclones, which can cause widespread damage to coastal regions of the world. A tsunami is another natural disaster that originates in the ocean. It is a huge and powerful wave generally caused by a strong earthquake or a volcanic eruption at the bottom of the ocean. Tsunamis can travel thousands of kilometres and submerge coastal areas, causing widespread damage.
