Trade flourished with the use of **punch-marked silver coins**, the first of their kind in India. These coins facilitated commerce not just within but also beyond the subcontinent. Roads like the Uttarapatha and Dakṣiṇapatha connected major regions. Urban centres like Śhiśhupalgarh and Kodumanal became hubs for crafts, gemstone work, and long-distance trade.
